Ask The Bounce Physio!!

Q. What is DOMS? What is the best way to recover from it? A. Delayed onset muscle soreness (DOMS), also called muscle fever, is the pain and stiffness felt in muscles several hours to days after unaccustomed or strenuous exercise. The soreness is felt most strongly 24 to 72 hours after the exercise, peaking usually around 48 hrs post exercise. It is thought to be caused by eccentric (lengthening) actions in sport or exercise, which causes micro trauma to the muscle fibres. After such exercise, the muscle adapts rapidly to prevent muscle damage, and thereby soreness, if the exercise is repeated. In football, it is unwise to schedule matches within 2-3 days especially in youth/amateur/ semiprofessional leagues due to the players' high levels of muscle fatigue. Recovery post match becomes critical & is important for players to adopt a professional approach to their recovery between matches & training sessions. To accelerate muscle recovery, scientific evidence suggests the following post match:

- Rehydration with large volume of water & sodium
- Drink flavoured milk &/or berry juice
- Eat a meal within the hour of high GI carbohydrate & protein
- Ice/ Cold Immersion baths
- 20 min per day utilising a high density foam roller
- Adequate sleep

Alcohol intake should be avoided until 4 hrs post match/ high intensity training THERE IS NO EVIDENCE SUPPORTING EITHER ACTIVE STRETCHING OR POST MATCH MASSAGE For more information please contact either Sandro or Dhara at Bounce Physio on 9344 7476
